PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

2019 is upon us! For many of us a New Year represents hope, change, and encouragement. We usually start off the New Year with lofty goals that we call resolutions that quickly fade or are simply forgotten by February. If you do not keep your resolution to exercise every day, or whatever your resolution may be, you are not a failure.

As with everything in life, it is important to look at our motives that drive our actions. For example, if resolution is to exercise more, then our desire is to be healthier physically. The motivation behind our desire to be healthier physically may be anything from wanting to look better to wanting to feel better so we can do more physical things, like play our kids or grandkids, to wanting to prolong our life and have more time with friends and family. When we examine our motives, we can see how even small changes can make a big difference over time.

Maybe instead of resolutions we can start by making smaller changes in our lives that work to transform us. Try making small changes and build on them over time. According to research, it is more effective to establish new habits, like stretching or exercising, in the morning. Starting small is also more effective, like starting with five minutes of stretching instead of shooting for thirty minutes, you can always increase the time gradually and may find that this happens naturally when you start to feel the healthy effects on your body. The same principle applies to spiritual practices as well. Instead of frantically searching for words to say in prayer, try written prayers and meditate on the words or you can even try being silent and letting God speak to you.
