The Plainfield Church Women known as PCW at the Plainfield Community Baptist Church is the Women’s Group. The PCW was first organized as the Ladies Aid Society on July 24, 1902 at a meeting held in the Vestry. The purpose and mission of the Church Women becoming an organized group was to better “aid the Church spiritually, financially and socially”. Our PCW meetings and activities are open to everyone and we invite all members and friends of our Church and community to join us for our activities and meetings. We continue to work together in fellowship, outreach and service. We hold meetings from September through June, and alternate the time between day and evening.

Each year the PCW helps support the work of the American Baptist Home Mission Societies. We give a donation to help both a domestic organization and an international ministry. On September 11, 2017 we voted to contribute three hundred dollars to the First Baptist Church of Caguas, Puerto Rico and two hundred dollars to the White Cross – Haiti International Ministries addressing medical and health needs. Both of these ministries experienced loss following the recent hurricanes, most recently Hurricane Irma.

As part of our PCW outreach, we provide receptions at our Church following funerals, burials and memorial services. The food is prepared, served and donated by members of our church and PCW. During 2017, we have participated in celebration of life and funeral service receptions.
